## **MARE MANAGEMENT CONTRACT**

\_\_\_\_\_ (“Owner”) agrees to allow Equine Sports Reproduction (“ESR”) to provide Reproductive Management Services for the 2010 breeding season, under the following conditions:

1. ESR will breed Owner’s non-embryo donor mares for a farm service fee (chute fee) of \$650.00. This fee includes all palpations, ultrasounds, routine inseminations, and record keeping. The farm service fee is due upon the mare’s arrival at ESR and does not carry forward to the 2010 season.
2. The chute fee for Owner’s embryo donor mares will be \$800.00. In the event the mare owner chooses to flush the mare, the mare owner must pay the difference in chute fees (\$150.00). This fee includes all ultrasounds, palpations, routine inseminations, and record keeping. Not included in the chute fee are uterine diagnostics, uterine treatments, blood hormone profiles, uterine culture & cytology, or any other testing or treatments given while at ESR. Embryo search and retrieval fees are not included in the chute fee and will be charged at the rate of \$350.00 per embryo flush. The chute fee is only applicable for one specified breeding cross. Chute fees will be applied accordingly for multiple stallions.
3. Additional charges will be incurred for some mares for the following services: breeding soundness examinations, special insemination procedures, uterine treatments, hormonal therapy and diagnostic testing. These items will be billed on a monthly basis.
4. The foaling fee will be \$400.00 for observation and attendance of normal foaling. This fee does not include complicated foaling or newborn care. The fee is due upon the mare’s arrival at ESR.
5. Mares will be boarded at ESR for \$20.00 per day for dry mares; \$25.00 per day for wet mares and \$20.00 per day for pregnant mares housed in the foaling barn awaiting foaling. The mare care charges are payable on a monthly basis.
6. Embryo Retrieval is available as outlined in item #2. Owner is responsible for making arrangements with an embryo receiving center for transfer to a recipient mare. A list of centers is available upon request.
7. All arrangements for stallion service will be made separately from this contract by the Owner.
8. Owner agrees that all mares are required to have permanent identification via microchip implantation. Mares without existing microchips will have one placed upon arrival at \$30.00, billed to mare Owner.
9. Owner agrees to pay all additional charges and boarding expenses prior to release of the mare. A credit card number will be on file at the time the mare is received by ESR and incurred fees will be charged monthly and/or upon mare’s release.
10. Owner agrees to allow ESR veterinary staff to check the mare and perform any veterinary services ESR deems necessary. This includes, but is not limited to, deworming, vaccination, treatment for infections, cuts and abrasions, and preventative measures.
11. Owner agrees to provide ESR with a negative Coggins report taken within ninety (90) days prior to arrival, or ESR will draw one at Owner’s expense.
12. Owner agrees to provide ESR with proof of vaccination within ninety (90) days prior to arrival for the following: Encephalitis, Tetanus, Influenza, Rhinopneumonitis, West Nile, Rabies, and Strep Equi (Strangles), or ESR will vaccinate at Owner’s expense.
13. Owner agrees that deworming and dental care will be current or ESR will provide services at Owner’s expense.

14. Owner agrees to provide ESR with proof of a Negative EVA Titer (Equine Viral Arteritis) drawn within 30 days or ESR will draw one at the Owner's expense. ESR does not require mares to be vaccinated for EVA. However, if Owner has vaccinated Mare prior to arrival at ESR than Owner agrees to provide ESR with the proof of the Negative EVA Titer results and vaccination records.
15. Owner understands ESR will not be responsible for any accident, sickness, or death to the mare, whether from fire, theft, act of God, or any other reason, and owner will exercise his/her judgment in caring for and supervising the mare. In the event of an injury or death to the mare, Owner will look solely to his/her own insurance. In the event anyone assesses a cause of action against Owner on account of any injury or death to mare, Owner agrees to hold ESR harmless from any such cause or action, including the cost of defending the same.

Thank you for entrusting Equine Sports Reproduction with your mare. We look forward to a successful 2010 breeding season.
